

# March 2016 California Economic Programs Workshops

## State and County Factoids

2/26/2016

### California

- **Professional, Scientific, & Technical Services** had the most employer businesses in 2013 (117k). It also had the most **nonemployer businesses** (516k)
  - Employers: Retail #2, Health Care and Social Assistance #3
  - **Nonemployers**: Other Services #2, Real Estate #3
- **Health Care** was largest employer sector in 2013 (nearly 1.8 million employees)
  - Retail #2, Accommodation and Food Services #3, Prof (etc) Svcs #4
- **Health Care** had the largest employment increase from 2007 to 2013 (up 191k)
  - Admin and Support and Waste Mgmt and Remediation #2
  - Construction and Manufacturing had the largest declines (-307k and -256k)
- **Information** had the highest average annual payroll per employee in 2013 (\$120k)
  - Management of Companies and Enterprises #2, Finance #3, Prof #4
- **Real Estate** had the highest receipts from **nonemployer businesses** in 2013 (\$36.8 billion) and also had the highest increase in receipts from 2007 to 2013 (up \$9.6 billion)
  - Prof etc #2

### Counties – NAICS 00

- Only **4** counties in the state saw an increase in the number of **employer businesses** from 2007 to 2013 (**SF** up 1878, **Santa Clara** up 588, **LA** up 223, and **Colusa** up 13)
  - **31** counties in the state saw an increase in the number of **nonemployer businesses** from 2007 to 2013
- Only **4** counties in the state saw an increase in the **number of employees** (of employer businesses) from 2007 to 2013 (**SF** up 34k, **Santa Clara** up 14k, **Kern** up 9.5k, and **Lassen** up 163)
- **29** counties in the state saw an increase in the number of **nonemployer business receipts** from 2007 to 2013
  - Only **19** counties in the state saw an increase in the **receipts per nonemployer business** from 2007 to 2013

### Counties

Imperial

- Employers
  - **Retail Trade** had the most businesses (468) and employment (7.6k) in 2013, while **Utilities** had the highest payroll per employee (\$76,809)

- **Real Estate and Rental and Leasing** grew the most businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 17), while **Health Care and Social Assistance** had the largest employment growth (up 425). **Admin and Support and Waste Management and Remediation** had the largest payroll per employee increase (up \$21,321)
- **Nonemployers**
  - **Other Services** had the most nonemployers in 2013 (1,805), while **Transportation and Warehousing** had the highest receipts (\$66 million). **Wholesale Trade** had the highest receipts per business (\$97,618).
  - **Admin** had the largest increase in businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 563) while **Real Estate** had the largest increase in receipts (up \$15 million) and receipts per business (up \$21,321).

#### Los Angeles

- **Employers**
  - **Prof (etc.)** had the most businesses (32k), while **Health Care** had the highest employment (505k) in 2013. **Finance** had the highest payroll per employee (\$103,892)
  - **Health Care** grew the most businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 2,690), while **Admin and Support** had the largest employment growth (up 77k). **Mining** had the largest payroll per employee increase (up \$55,807)
- **Nonemployers**
  - **Other Services** had the most nonemployers in 2013 (157,476), while **Real Estate and Rental and Leasing** had the highest receipts (\$12.3 Billion) and the highest receipts per business (\$134,676).
  - **Other Services** had the largest increase in businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 39,793) while **Real Estate** had the largest increase in receipts (up \$3.8 billion) and receipts per business (up \$32,761).

#### Riverside

- **Employers**
  - **Retail** had the most businesses (5,044) and employment (85k) in 2013, while **Mgmt of Companies** had the highest payroll per employee (\$77,200)
  - **Health Care** grew the most businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 487), while **Accommodation and Food Services** had the largest employment growth (up 11k). **Finance** had the largest payroll per employee increase (up \$8,934)
- **Nonemployers**
  - **Other Services** had the most nonemployers in 2013 (26,877), while **Real Estate and Rental and Leasing** had the highest receipts (\$1.1 Billion). **Wholesale Trade** had the highest receipts per business (\$97,390).

- **Other Services** had the largest increase in businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 5,656) while **Real Estate** had the largest increase in receipts (up \$183 million). **Mining** had the largest increase in receipts per business (up \$40,593).

## Sacramento

- **Employers**
  - **Prof (etc.)** had the most businesses (3,779), while **Health Care** had the highest employment (76k) in 2013. **Mining** had the highest payroll per employee (\$109,956)
  - **Education Services** grew the most businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 58), while **Health Care** had the largest employment growth (up 6,769). **Wholesale** had the largest payroll per employee increase (up \$31,119)
- **Nonemployers**
  - **Other Services** had the most nonemployers in 2013 (16,456), while **Real Estate and Rental and Leasing** had the highest receipts (\$864.5 million) and the highest receipts per business (\$98,962).
  - **Other Services** had the largest increase in businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 2,943) while **Transportation and Warehousing** had the largest increase in receipts (up \$254.6 million). **Utilities** had the largest increase in receipts per business (up \$42,037).

## San Diego

- **Employers**
  - **Prof (etc.)** had the most businesses (12,881), while **Health Care** had the highest employment (152k) in 2013. **Information** had the highest payroll per employee (\$88,449)
  - **Health Care** grew the most businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 716) and also had the largest employment growth (up 17,545). **Finance** had the largest payroll per employee increase (up \$15,833)
- **Nonemployers**
  - **Prof (etc.)** had the most nonemployers in 2013 (49,659), while **Real Estate and Rental and Leasing** had the highest receipts (\$3.1 billion) and the highest receipts per business (\$112,705).
  - **Other Services** had the largest increase in businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 5,983) while **Real Estate** had the largest increase in receipts (up \$702.6 million) and the largest increase in receipts per business (up \$25,575).

## San Francisco

- **Employers**
  - **Prof (etc.)** had the most businesses (6,538) and had the highest employment (88k) in 2013. **Finance** had the highest payroll per employee (\$109,956)

- **Accommodation and Food Services** grew the most businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 724), while **Information** had the largest employment growth (up 24,535) and the largest payroll per employee increase (up \$54,853)
- **Nonemployers**
  - **Prof (etc.)** had the most nonemployers in 2013 (25,470), while **Real Estate and Rental and Leasing** had the highest receipts (\$1.5 billion) and the highest receipts per business (\$166,990).
  - **Prof (etc.)** had the largest increase in businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 3,289) while **Real Estate** had the largest increase in receipts (up \$369.8 million). **Utilities** had the largest increase in receipts per business (up \$75,000).

#### San Joaquin

- **Employers**
  - **Retail** had the most businesses (1,595), while **Health Care** had the highest employment (28k) in 2013. **Utilities** had the highest payroll per employee (\$104,935)
  - **Transportation and Warehousing** grew the most businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 39) and had the largest employment growth (up 2,191). **Utilities** had the largest payroll per employee increase (up \$33,478)
- **Nonemployers**
  - **Other Services** had the most nonemployers in 2013 (6,135), while **Transportation and Warehousing** had the highest receipts (\$399.5 million) and the highest receipts per business (\$110,383).
  - **Other Services** had the largest increase in businesses from 2007 to 2013 (up 1,184) while **Transportation and Warehousing** had the largest increase in receipts (up \$88.9 million). **Real Estate and Rental and Leasing** had the largest increase in receipts per business (up \$28,456).
