SANDAG Revised 2016 STIP Submittal SUBJECT:

Pursuant to the January 2016 California Transportation Commission (Commission) action that reduced the 2016 Fund Estimate, the SANDAG Board of Directors approved a revision to the 2016 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) reducing the program by the region's proportionate share to the overall 2016 STIP funding capacity.

We encourage the Commission to review the various proposed revised STIPs with a statewide view, and to prioritize the limited funds on projects that are consistent with the general priorities outlined in the allocation plan. As noted in the past, the Interstate (I)-5 North Coast (NCC) project is one of the region's highest priorities and supports the state's multi-modal approach to reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions. The project is ready to begin construction.

Table 1 shows the revised 2016 STIP programming proposal for consideration by the California Transportation Commission.

We share the Commission's frustrations with the lack of transportation funding, and appreciate the effort in urging the Legislature to take action to maintain and augment transportation funding statewide.

The SANDAG Board of Directors continues to aggressively move forward with regionally significant projects that would relieve congestion, maintain job growth, and improve overall mobility. The STIP share of the I-5 NCC project is an integral part of ensuring the implementation of important regional projects. In order to ensure that the project remains on schedule, SANDAG plans to request an AB 3090 contingent on the adoption of the 2016 STIP by the Commission. We appreciate the Commission's partnership in helping the San Diego region achieve our mobility goals.

Although the overall programming is being reduced for one of the region's high priority projects, SANDAG plans to ensure the project remains on its current schedule; as a result, only the Project Programming Request is revised, no other update or revision to the overall STIP package is necessary. As such the already submitted performance measures, compliance with Greenhouse Gas Emissions, and other consistency with the long range plan issues remain the same. The newly created STIP website (www.sandag.org\STIP) will be updated accordingly.

SECTION 1 - All Projects

Project Background

The project is a component of the larger I-5 North Coast Corridor parent project (PPNO 0615) which environmentally cleared the 27-mile corridor in August of 2014. This project is phase 1 of the larger 30 year program. The project was originally split into three proposed projects (PPNO 0615A, 0615B, and 0615C). This amendment proposes to re-combine these projects into 0615C due to the CMGC delivery method.

Programming Change Requested

The amendment reduces the STIP share by \$41M in light of the reduction to the overall 2016 STIP. Region anticipates filling the gap with local and/or federal sources.

Reason for Proposed Change

The reduction is in response to request by CTC to reduce the STIP based on its regional share, although it is anticipated that CTC will manage the STIP funding at a state level.
