## Jobs in the Region

- Reflect wider range of jobs to account for the "Gig Economy" - both wage and salary and non-wage and salary
- Greater increase in non-wage and salary jobs the past ten years, compared to wage and salary jobs
- Changes in labor force participation rates by older individuals expected
- Consideration of what percent of jobs are held by San Diego County population
