

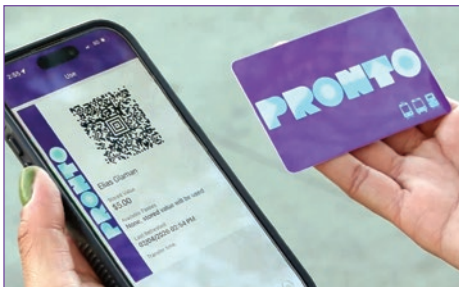


Youth Opportunity Pass



This program offers unlimited free transit rides in the San Diego region on the bus, Trolley, COASTER, and SPRINTER for people ages 18 and under. Since its launch, it has provided more than 39 million free rides!

Follow these steps to get started.



Step 1: Get a PRONTO Pass

On a smartphone, download the **PRONTO San Diego app** (for **Android** / for **iOS**) and register for an account.

Without a smartphone, ask your school's office for a PRONTO card or buy one for \$2 (find participating retail locations at ridepronto.com/get-a-card). Then register for an online PRONTO account at ridepronto.com.

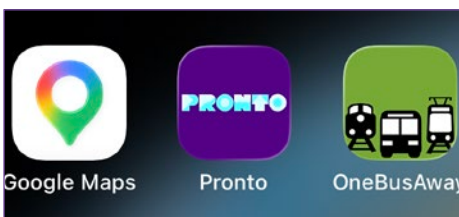


Step 2: Verify Your Age

Log in to your PRONTO account at ridepronto.com and select **"Apply for Youth, Senior, Disabled Pass"** from the left menu. Select your card and choose "Youth" as the "Reduced Fare Type." Enter your information and upload your **proof of age** and a profile photo.

Once you submit your application, MTS will review it within 10 days. When your virtual PRONTO card shows "Youth," you are ready to ride for free.

To verify in person, bring proof of age to any Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) or North County Transit District (NCTD) Customer Service Centers. Staff can activate your Youth Pass immediately.



Step 3: Plan Your Trips

Use Google Maps, Apple Maps, the PRONTO app, or the OneBusAway app to plan your route and check real-time arrival information.

Remember to arrive at your stop early and scan your app or tap your card every time you ride.

*NOTE: Children ages five and under ride MTS and NCTD free at all times and do not need a PRONTO card or app account, nor do they need to provide proof of their age.
