HELPFUL HINTS:

HOW TO DO BUSINESS WITH SANDAG

The San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) is interested in doing business with you! Below are a few simple steps that will help your firm understand and participate in the SANDAG procurement process.

1. Follow these steps to learn more about doing business with SANDAG.
 - a. **Register your firm** at the SANDAG vendor database located at www.sandag.org/contracts to receive e-mails of upcoming projects. There is no cost to register.
PLEASE NOTE: If you previously submitted the SANDAG vendor questionnaire, you **MUST** re-register through this online process to receive e-mail notifications about current contracting opportunities. SANDAG is no longer mailing notifications of projects to firms.
 - b. After registering, view a list of SANDAG **current bids**.
 - c. At any time, view future contracting opportunities in the tentative **list of upcoming projects**.

2. Attend pre-bid, pre-proposal, and pre-statement of qualifications meetings to hear important details about projects and to network with other firms. Meeting dates will be announced on the SANDAG Web site.
3. If your firm qualifies, get certified as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise.



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
