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TECHNICAL MEMORANDUM # 4

Technical Memorandum #3 described the draft sampling methodology and survey instruments developed by True North Research for the San Diego Association of Governments' study: *Estimating the Economic Impacts of Border Wait Times at the San Diego-Baja California Border Region Framework*.¹ Aspects of the sampling methodology, as well as the draft survey instruments, were pre-tested by Youexport and True North Research on October 28th and 29th, 2004. The purpose of the pre-test was to identify any logistical or theoretical challenges introduced by the border environment (not already accounted for in the methodology) and what their impact may be on the reliability of the data collected. Moreover, the pre-test offered an opportunity to test the integrity of the survey instruments.

The purpose of this memo is to briefly describe the pre-test, highlight the issues that were raised in terms of sampling and the survey instruments, as well as describe changes to the methodology that were motivated by the pre-test. This memo also contains the final versions of the survey instruments that will be used in the field.

OVERVIEW OF STUDY For the reader's background, the sampling methodology and survey instruments discussed in this memo will be used to select and collect information from northbound border crossers at the Otay Mesa-Mesa de Otay, San Ysidro-Puerta México, and Tecate-Tecate points of entry. Crossers traveling in personal vehicles and buses, as well as individuals crossing on foot or using non-motorized forms of transportation (e.g., bicycle), represent the universe of individuals for the study. The information collected through the survey will be used to develop an economic model that estimates the impacts of border delays on the economies of the San Diego-northern Baja California region.

PRE-TEST DESCRIPTION AND ISSUES The pre-test was originally scheduled to begin at 9 AM on October 28, 2004, at the Otay Mesa-Mesa de Otay point of entry (POE). Due to heavy rain and foul weather, however, the pre-test was rescheduled for the next morning (October 29) and was moved to the San Ysidro-Puerta México POE.²

Over the course of 3 hours, the team of interviewers completed a total of 52 surveys -- 25 with pedestrians, 25 with individuals in personal vehicles, and 2 with bus passengers. In general, the sampling methodology and data collection protocol worked well and as planned. Respondents were typically cooperative, understood the meaning of the questions posed, and were able to provide meaningful answers. However, several issues were identified that motivated changes to the research methodology. A short description of each issue, as well as how the methodology was changed to accommodate the issue, is presented in the following pages.

 2. It should be noted that Valdemar Carvajal of Youexport made great efforts to coordinate with, and gain the cooperation of, the proper officials in the United States and Mexico to conduct the pre-test and the study. His groundwork -- which included multiple meetings with Directors, Assistant Directors and Senior staff at each of the ports of interest to this study -- has enabled the study to proceed smoothly on this front.

Wet Weather Most of interviews are conducted outside in unprotected areas. When it rains, respondents are naturally unwilling to stand in the rain or roll their car windows down to participate in the interview. Accordingly, if it is raining steadily at a time scheduled for data collection, the data collection will be postponed to a similar time and day.

SENTRI Lanes SENTRI lanes, by design, move quickly -- too quickly to attempt an interview on the Mexican side of the border. Working with Customs and port decision-makers, Youexport has secured their cooperation in randomly selecting SENTRI users and sending them to secondary inspection for the purpose of completing the interview.³

Trip Purpose & Residency One concern that was expressed during the design of the study was that some non-U.S. citizens who have obtained a green card may be reluctant to answer where they live and/or their trip purpose because they live in Mexico while working in the United States. Although not apparent during the pre-test, this pattern has appeared in the first week of actual data collection. Interviewers have reported that some respondents who are obviously crossing the border to work in the United States⁴ are initially reluctant to disclose the true purpose of their trip. In cases where the interviewer has sufficient reason to suspect that the person is traveling for work purposes, the protocol has been changed to allow the interviewer to use one or more approaches to try to encourage a truthful response on the part of the respondent. These include asking the trip purpose question in a presumptive manner⁵ and assuring the respondent that they are not affiliated with U.S. Customs or the "INS".⁶

Survey Length The length of the survey for people whose primary trip purpose was for work averaged 12 minutes during the pre-test. At this length, it was discovered that it would be difficult to complete interviews in many situations. For example, when the traffic lines were short (which occurs semi-regularly during certain off-peak periods of the day, especially at the Otay Mesa-Mesa de Otay and Tecate-Tecate POEs), there is simply not enough time to engage and complete the interview before a personal vehicle must cross the border. Bus passengers were also not willing to spend this much time to take the interview for fear that their bus would leave without them. In some cases, respondents' tolerance and willingness to participate in the interview also declined somewhat as the interview began to take more time than they expected.

To reduce the average interview length for people whose primary trip purpose was for work to a manageable 7 to 8 minutes (on average) *without* eliminating questions from the survey, the research teamed recommended (and SANDAG approved) a split-sample approach. Put simply, individuals whose primary trip purpose is work or business-related will receive either the questions pertaining to expenditures (Section 5) *or* the detailed work trip questions (Section 6).⁷ The

3. Because this method requires the cooperation and coordination with Customs agents, SENTRI lane interviews will be concentrated during a representative subset of primary sampling units rather than during every primary sampling unit selected for data collection.
4. In some cases, for example, it is obvious that the person is traveling to work in the United States because they are wearing a work uniform for a San Diego company or hotel.
5. In other words, rather than asking "what is the primary purpose for your trip today?", the interviewer can ask "Your primary purpose for crossing the border is for work today?" or some variation on this statement.

questionnaires included in this memo display the explicit split-sample instructions, and show the questions that are affected.

The benefit of employing a split-sample approach is that the study will still capture data on all of the variables of interest for work-related trips -- both expenditure-related variables and detailed work trip variables. One cost of this approach, however, is that it will effectively reduce the sample size by approximately 50% for both of these question series, which will increase the statistical margins of error due to sampling associated with estimating the true value of the variables.⁸

East Otay Mesa POE At the request of SANDAG, a question was added to the end of the survey regarding a proposed point of entry that may be built in East Otay Mesa that would provide a faster way to cross the border for people who are willing to pay a fee. The question asks whether the respondent would use this point of entry if the fee were three dollars each time they crossed into the United States.

QUESTIONNAIRES The following pages present the final questionnaires that will be used to conduct the interviews. To make the questionnaires 'user friendly' for data collection personnel, they have been reformatted from the original draft versions presented in Technical Memorandum #3.

8. The magnitude of the increase in the statistical margin of error due to the reduction in sample size will depend, in part, on the distribution of responses to each question as well as the nature of the parameter being estimated -- percentage, mean or total -- and thus will vary for each question. The overall margins of error for key variables of interest will be estimated once the data has been collected and analyzed.
