SUBJECT: SANDAG 2004/05-2006/07 FSTIP AMENDMENT NUMBER 3

We have completed our review of Amendment No. 3 to the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) 2004 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) that was submitted by your letter dated January 26, 2005. The SANDAG Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 2005-13 on January 21, 2005, approving these RTIP modifications and reaffirming the conformity of the transportation improvement program with the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality. As detailed in the enclosure to your letter, this SANDAG RTIP amendment proposes to remove 1 project, add 12 projects, and modify 33 projects listed in the triennial element of California's 2004/05-2006/07 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Based on our review, Amendment No. 3 to the SANDAG RTIP increases RTIP/FSTIP funding commitments to projects in the SANDAG region by \$23.435 million in program year 2004/05, decreases funding commitments by \$32.946 million in year 2005/06, and increases funding commitments by \$10.241 million in year 2006/07.

We find that SANDAG's 2004/05-2006/07 RTIP, including Amendment No. 3, was developed through a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accord with the metropolitan transportation planning provisions of 23 USC §134 and 49 USC Chapter 53. We have determined that the adopted modifications to the SANDAG FTIP, proposed for inclusion in California's FSTIP by this amendment, are exempt from the regional emissions analysis and conformity determination requirements of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) Transportation Conformity Rule as amended. Our transportation planning and air quality conformity findings have been coordinated with the regional offices of the U.S. EPA and Federal Transit Administration. We are approving this amendment to the 2004/05-2006/07 FSTIP for the SANDAG region pursuant to the Federal statewide and metropolitan transportation planning regulations codified in 23 CFR Part 450, and in accord with the July 15, 2004, *Memorandum of Understanding between the Federal Highway Administration, California Division, and the Federal Transit Administration, Region IX.*
