SUBJECT: SANDAG 2006 RTIP/FSTIP Amendment No. 1

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have completed our reviews of Amendment No. 1 to the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) 2006 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) that was submitted by your letter dated November 9, 2006. The SANDAG Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 2007-11 on October 27, 2006, approving these RTIP modifications and reaffirming the conformity of the transportation improvement program with the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality. As detailed in the enclosure to your letter, this SANDAG RTIP amendment proposes to delete one project listing, add six new project listings and modify the funding or description for 38 previously listed projects, in the triennial element of California's 2006/07-2008/09 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Based on our review of the RTIP financial constraint documentation that was submitted with this amendment, we have determined that the amended RTIP is financially constrained as required by 23 CFR 450.324. Pursuant to 23 CFR 450.216, project programming information provided for additional years beyond the current FSTIP triennial element is accepted by the FHWA and the FTA for information purposes.

We find that SANDAG's 2006 RTIP, including Amendment No. 1, was developed through a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accord with the metropolitan transportation planning provisions of 23 USC §134 and 49 USC Chapter 53. We have determined that the adopted modifications to the SANDAG RTIP, proposed for inclusion in California's FSTIP by this amendment, are exempt from the regional emissions analysis requirements of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) Transportation Conformity Rule as amended. Our transportation planning and air quality conformity findings have been coordinated with the regional offices of the U.S. EPA and FTA. We are approving this amendment to the 2006 FSTIP for the SANDAG region pursuant to the Federal statewide



and metropolitan transportation planning regulations codified in 23 CFR Part 450, and in accord with the *July 15, 2004, Memorandum of Understanding between the FHWA, California Division, and the FTA, Region IX*.
