The proposed Robinson Bikeway will provide a vital connection for residents to walk and bike between two vibrant communities within San Diego's urban core – North Park and Hillcrest. The bikeway will run along Robinson Avenue between Park Boulevard and Alabama Street. Features include an elevated path to bridge the Florida Canyon between Florida and Alabama streets, buffered bike lanes, crosswalks, and traffic calming features designed to make Robinson Avenue more pleasant for everyone – people who walk, bike, work, and live there.
