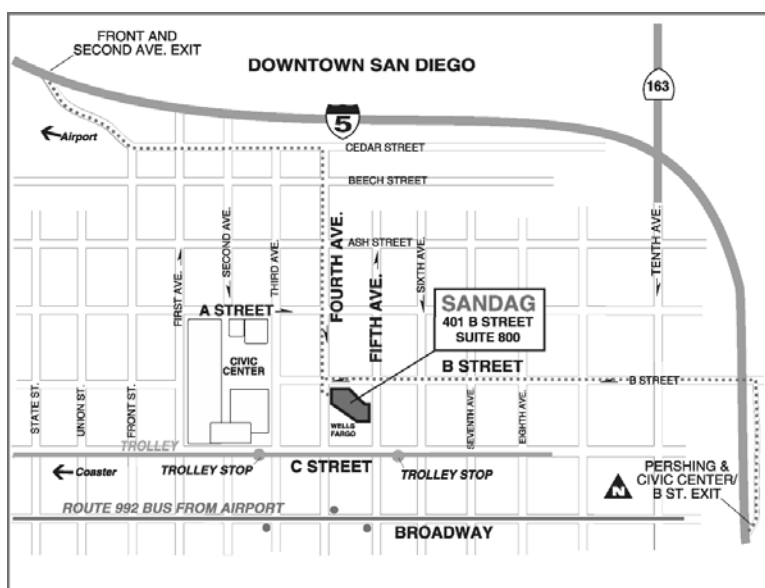
Participants will depart from SANDAG at 9:15 a.m., take the Trolley to the Santa Fe Depot, and board the 9:45 a.m. COASTER to Oceanside. The COASTER will make stops in Old Town (9:50 a.m.), Sorrento Valley (10:10 a.m.), Solana Beach (10:19 a.m.), Encinitas (10:24 a.m.), Carlsbad Poinsettia (10:30 a.m.), and Carlsbad Village (10:37 a.m.) before arriving in Oceanside at 10:45 a.m. An accessible bus will pick up participants at the Oceanside Transit Station to continue the tour. The bus will return to SANDAG by 3 p.m. Trolley and COASTER tickets will be provided.
