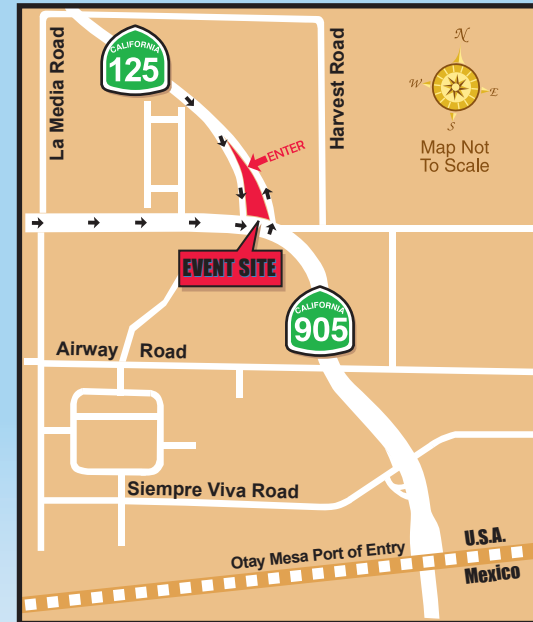

The event will take place in the median of the southernmost end of State Route 125 (SR-125) overlooking SR-905 (Thomas Guide Page 1351, J-1).

Directions: Take southbound SR-125 to SR-905. At the signal turn left, then proceed to the SR-125 northbound on-ramp. Stay in your left-hand lane and flaggers will assist motorists into the event site. NOTE- Guests using SR-125 will pay a toll.

Alternate directions - South I-5 or I-805 to eastbound SR-905. Proceed to the SR-125 northbound on-ramp. Stay in your left-hand lane and flaggers will assist motorists into the event site. Guide signs will also be posted to direct media to the event site.
