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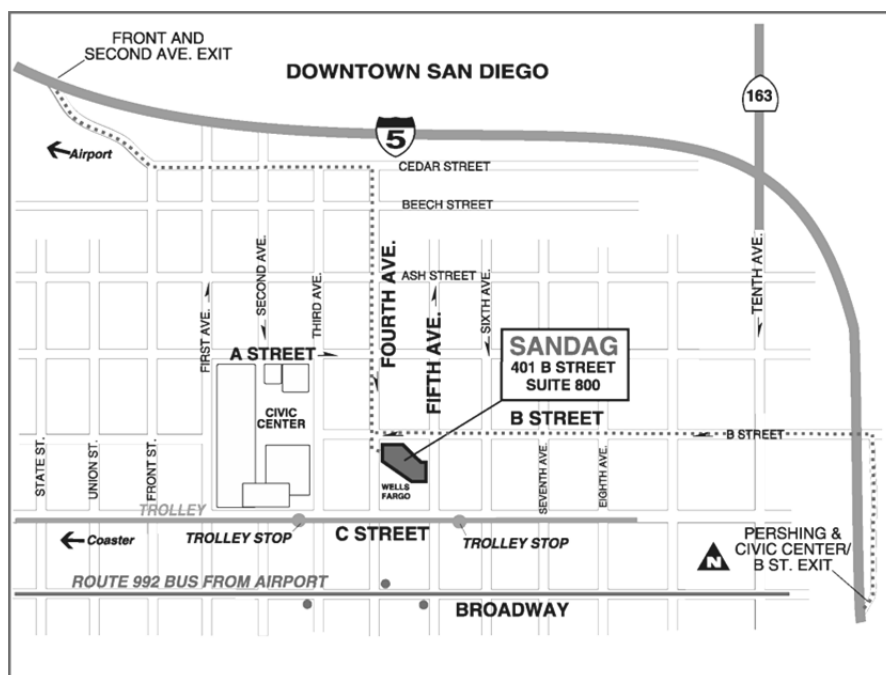

5. PRESCRIPTION DRUG ABUSE AMONG SAN DIEGO COUNTY ARRESTEES INFORMATION  
(Cynthia Burke)

National statistics reveal that prescription drug abuse is the second most common illegal drug problem in the U.S. and is increasing, possibly due to accessibility and the "normalization" of use. As part of the Substance Abuse Monitoring project, in which arrestees are interviewed in local detention facilities, questions are asked regarding illicit use of prescription drugs. An overview of these data and local efforts to address this issue will be provided.

6. SAN DIEGO COUNTY'S LAW ENFORCEMENT COORDINATION CENTER INFORMATION  
(Captain Lee Yoder, San Diego County Sheriff's Department)

The Law Enforcement Coordination Center (LECC) brings together local, state, federal, and tribal partners to help ensure public safety by preventing and combating both traditional crime and terrorist threats. The LECC provides an effective and efficient mechanism to exchange information and intelligence, maximize resources, streamline operations, and improve the ability of law enforcement to fight crime and terrorism. An overview of the LECC, participating partners, and associated responsibilities will be provided.

7. PUBLIC SAFETY ON COLLEGE CAMPUSES: AN OVERVIEW OF POLICING AT SAN DIEGO STATE UNIVERSITY (Captain Lamine Secka, SDSU) INFORMATION

San Diego State University (SDSU) is a community of more than 40,000 students, faculty, and staff located in the City and County of San Diego. 4. REPORT FROM THE CHIEFS'/SHERIFF'S MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (INFORMATION)

Chief John L. Browning (County Chiefs'/Sheriff's Association) gave an update on the Chiefs'/Sheriff's Management Committee meeting held on December 7, 2011.

5. REPORT FROM THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY FIRE CHIEFS ASSOCIATION (INFORMATION)

Chief Tony Michel (Regional Fire/Emergency Medical Services) reported on the November 3, 2011, meeting of the San Diego County Fire Chiefs Association.

6. SAN DIEGO COUNTYWIDE POWER OUTAGE: AFTER ACTION REPORT (INFORMATION)

Assistant Director Herman Reddick (San Diego County Office of Emergency Services) gave an overview of efforts taken and lessons learned from the September 8, 2011, Pacific Southwest major power outage.

7. LAW ENFORCEMENT'S RESPONSE TO MENTAL ILLNESS AND PSYCHIATRIC EMERGENCIES (INFORMATION)

Assistant Chief Boyd Long (San Diego Police Department) presented an overview of how law enforcement works collaboratively with mental health providers when responding to City of San Diego law enforcement calls for service relating to mental health issues. Assistant Chief Long also discussed the increase in homicides during the first half of 2011 and whether homicide/suicide incidents may be contributing to the increase in numbers.

8. HOMICIDES AND SUICIDES IN SAN DIEGO COUNTY – THE MEDICAL EXAMINER PERSPECTIVE (INFORMATION)

Dr. Jonathan Lucas (County of San Diego Medical Examiner's Office) gave a PowerPoint presentation on the patterns and trends of homicides and suicides in San Diego County along with homicide/suicide incidents. Preliminary statistics from 2011 were also provided.

9. SAN DIEGO COUNTY'S SUICIDE PREVENTION ACTION PLAN (INFORMATION)

Dr. Jennifer Schaffer (County of San Diego Health and Human Services Agency) and Ms. Holly Salazar (Community Health Improvement Partners) gave a PowerPoint presentation on a new San Diego County Suicide Prevention Action plan. They described how the plan fits in as part of the County's "Live Well, San Diego!" initiative.
