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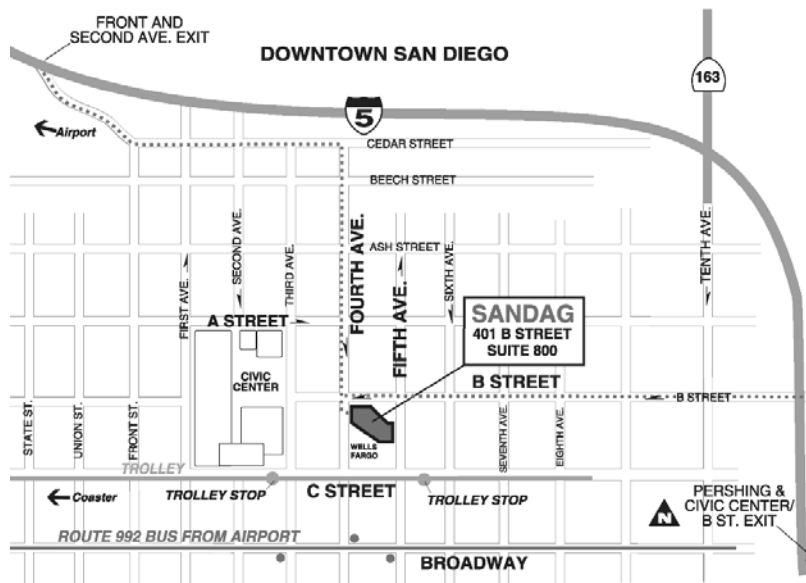

5.	REGIONAL BIKE WAYFINDING SIGNAGE DESIGN GUIDELINES (Bridget Enderle)	INFORMATION
<p>The Regional Bike Wayfinding Signage Design Guidelines project will produce wayfinding design guidelines for the San Diego Regional Bike Network to ensure consistent and comprehensive wayfinding sign implementation. The guidelines will also be a tool for local jurisdictions to use to promote consistency and compatibility between the regional and local bike networks. This project supports implementation of Riding to 2050: San Diego Regional Bike Plan (Regional Bike Plan). One of the policy objectives of the Regional Bike Plan is to "improve the connectivity and quality of the regional bicycle network" and implementing bicycle wayfinding signage is among the policy actions identified to accomplish this objective. Staff will provide an overview of the design guidelines, summarize existing conditions and best practices findings, and present preliminary sign design concepts.</p>

The meeting of the San Diego Regional Traffic Engineers Council (SANTEC) was called to order by Chair Minjie Mei (City of Santee) at 9:40 a.m.

1. INTRODUCTION
2. PUBLIC COMMENTS

No public comments were entered.

3. APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES (APPROVE)

Review and approval of the April 16, 2015, meeting minutes.

Action: Upon a motion by Ryan Zellars (City of Del Mar) and a second by Murali Pasumarthi (County of San Diego), the meeting minutes of the April 16, 2015, SANTEC meeting were approved.

Yes - Chair Mei, Carlana Darrieulat (Caltrans), Jim Newton (City of Coronado), Mr. Zellars, Luke Baker (City of Encinitas), Ali Shazad (City of Escondido), Kathy Feinlen (City of La Mesa), David DiPierro (City of Oceanside), Duncan Hughes (City of San Diego), Jim Greenstein (City of Solana Beach), and Murali Pasumarthi (County of San Diego); No – None; Abstain – Hussan Hasenin (City of Vista); Absent – City of Carlsbad, City of Chula Vista, City of El Cajon, City of Imperial Beach, City of Lemon Grove, City of San Marcos, City of Poway, and Metropolitan Transit System.

4. ELECTION OF NEW VICE CHAIR (DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION)

Action: Upon a motion by Ms. Feinlen for the position of Vice Chair, seconded by Mr. Hughes, Ms. Feinlen was voted in as the SANTEC Vice Chair. .

REPORTS

5. MEMBER COMMUNICATIONS (INFORMATION)

A request by Chair Mei was made to remove Item 5 “Member Communications” to Item 12 “Matters from Members.”

6. DRAFT SAN DIEGO FORWARD: THE REGIONAL PLAN (INFORMATION)

Laurie Gartrell (SANDAG) provided SANTEC members with an overview of the current Draft San Diego Forward: The Regional Plan. Ms. Gartrell announced that on April 24, 2015, the SANDAG Board of Directors released the Draft Regional Plan and its Sustainable Communities Strategy, along with the Draft Air Quality Conformity Analysis for public review and comment. The Draft Environmental Impact Report was to be released later that day. Staff noted that during the public review period, SANDAG has hosted a series of seven public meetings throughout the region. The Draft Regional Plan and public comment form are available at sdforward.com.

7. INTERSTATE 8 CORRIDOR STUDY ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION ANALYSIS (INFORMATION)

Scott Strelecki (SANDAG) provided an overview of the Caltrans funded planning grant that will analyze the Interstate 8 (I-8) Corridor. Staff discussed the approach to analysis, current analysis outcomes, and next steps. Staff noted that the approach to operational improvement analysis of the I-8 Corridor was furthered by inclusion of Active Transportation, Transportation Demand Management, and Transportation Systems Management assessments.

Christine Eary (SANDAG) provided SANTEC members with an overview of the analysis approach that had been taken by the Active Transportation consultant group. Working to identify high priority projects within the corridor, staff provided input to SANTEC on the focus and approach to justification that had been used in their assessments of the I-8 Corridor.

SANTEC members asked questions related to the depth of the analysis conducted for the non-traditional operational enhancements and scope of the study.

8. REGIONAL BIKE NETWORK BRAND (INFORMATION)

Elizabeth Cox (SANDAG) provided SANTEC members with an overview of the new brand for the San Diego Regional Bike Network representing regional bikeway projects, programs, and services. Staff provided input on how branding had been developed with broad public input on the preferred marketing approach, and how the outcome would encourage more people to make the choice to ride a bike as a transportation alternative across the San Diego region’s 1,300 miles of bike network. Staff provided a PowerPoint presentation discussing the alternatives considered and examples of how the branding templates would be applied.

SANTEC Member asked how the San Diego Regional Bike Network branding could be applied to recent active transportation projects completed within their jurisdictions. SANDAG staff took the action of following these requests to provide the needed information.

9. CITY OF SOLANA BEACH HIGHWAY 101 REVITALIZATION PROJECT (INFORMATION)

Mr. Greenstein provided a presentation on the recently completed streetscape project on the historic highway. He discussed the history of planning for the project, project scope, budget, and lessons learned at completion. Providing examples of the improvements made, Mr. Greenstein remarked on those areas of the project that sought to highlight "choice" for alternative transportation modes.

SANTEC members discussed the approach to operational planning with Mr. Greenstein, providing feedback on the examples provided.

10. CALTRANS UPDATES (INFORMATION)

The Caltrans District Local Assistance Engineer representative provided SANTEC members with an update on Local Assistance Notifications.

11. CITIES/COUNTY TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING BRIEFING (INFORMATION)

No Cities/County Transportation Advisory Committee members were present at the SANTEC meeting. A summary was deferred for future SANTEC meetings.

12. MATTERS FROM MEMBERS (INFORMATION)

A discussion on street lighting electricity expenses was raised for input from SANTEC members. A request to have a future presentation discussing SANTEC member experience was requested.

13. UPCOMING MEETINGS (INFORMATION)

The next SANTEC meeting is scheduled for July 16, 2015.

14. ADJOURNMENT

Chair Mei adjourned the meeting at 11:06 a.m.
