# DRAFT Shoreline Preservation Task Force Charter

- **Purpose:** Provide technical expertise, background knowledge and cross-agency coordination on regional shoreline issues.
- **Responsibilities:**
  1. Forum for collaborate, coordinate and peer exchange
  2. Collaboration on coastal resilience policy and projects
  3. Promote best practices and technical assistance
  4. Support regional beach nourishment efforts and the Regional Coastal Shoreline Monitoring Program

# DRAFT Shoreline Preservation Task Force Charter

- **Membership:**

- Coastal and Bayfront Cities and County of San Diego
- Port of San Diego
- U.S. Navy
- Technical advisors
  - Coastal Commission, State Boating and Waterways, State Lands, State Park and Recreation, State Fish and Wildlife, National Marine Fisheries, U.S. Army Corps
- Community advisors
  - Southern California Tribal Chair's Assoc., non-profit coastal advocacy groups, fishing community, scientific community, and environmental justice/climate equity community.

# DRAFT Shoreline Preservation Task Force Charter

- **Elected Officials:** Coastal and Bayfront Cities and County may choose an elected official as their representative to the taskforce.
- **Chair:** Taskforce will select a Chair from their members for a period of two years.
- **Meeting Frequency:** Every quarter or as needed depending on workload.
- **Duration:** Reviewed each fiscal year and will continue to meet so long as there is a regional need for the taskforce.
