The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has completed the review of the following amendment to the San Diego Association of Governments' (SANDAG) 2012/13 - 2015/16 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

5	<b>State, Local, and Transit Elements</b> This amendment adds, deletes, and modifies projects from various funding sources in San Diego County. It includes individual and grouped projects with funding from the State Highway Operation and Protection Program, Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program, Surface Transportation Program, High Priority Project Program, State Transportation Improvement Program, Federal Transit Administration (FTA) 5317, 5316, 5311 and local funds.

The SANDAG Board Resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that projects included meet all applicable transportation planning requirements per Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations Part 450 and satisfy the applicable air quality conformity requirements.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Director of Caltrans, I approve SANDAG's Amendment Number 5. I also recommend that the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and FTA approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2013 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Projects included in this FTIP amendment, in fiscal years not within the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of this FTIP amendment and are shown for information only. Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of project for federal funding.
