Arterial Roadway Miles per Acre (High Volume Arterials)	7.3 miles/acre	8.4 miles/acre	-	Compared to the City of San Diego, San Ysidro has slightly fewer high volume arterial roadways per acre.
Average Vehicles Miles Traveled per Acre (Traffic Density)	33.1 VMT/acre	46.2 VMT/acre	-	Compared to the City of San Diego, San Ysidro has slightly less Vehicle Miles Traveled per acre.

Transportation Infrastructure Support Index (Transit Service, Trail Access, Sidewalk Coverage)	0.694	0.273	++	Compared to the City of San Diego, San Ysidro has a more supportive transportation infrastructure, overall (transit service, trail access, sidewalks).
Walkability Index (Retail, Land Use Mix, Residential Density, Intersection Density)	-0.729	0.625	---	Compared to the City of San Diego overall, San Ysidro is significantly less walkable.
Youth Physical Activity Support (Trail Access, Sidewalks, Elementary School Access)	0.567	0.249	++	Compared to the City of San Diego, San Ysidro has greater infrastructure in place to support youth physical activity, overall.
Physical Activity Inhibitors (Traffic Density, High Volume Arterials, Vacant Parcels, Property Crime, Violent Crime)	0.144	0.001	+++	Compared to the City of San Diego overall, the San Ysidro community environment is significantly less supportive of physical activity in general.

Cyclist Safety (Cyclist Collisions, Traffic Density, Arterial Density)	0.033	-0.034	+++	Compared to the City of San Diego, the overall safety of bicyclists is significantly less.
Youth Traffic Safety (Access to Parks, Schools, Daycare, Cyclist Collision, Pedestrian Collisions, Traffic Density, Arterial Density, Sidewalks)	0.149	-0.001	+++	Compared to the City of San Diego, overall youth traffic safety is significantly less.

Average Annual Violent Crime per 1,000 population	12.3	7.5	++	Compared to the City of San Diego overall, San Ysidro has a significantly higher rate of violent crime (almost double).
Average Annual Property Crime per 1,000 population	7.9	5.6	++	Compared to the City of San Diego overall, San Ysidro has a slightly higher rate of property crime.
