The projects include funding from the State Highway Operation and Protection Program, Active Transportation Program, Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program, Regional Surface Transportation Program, Highway Bridge Program and local funds.

The SANDAG board resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that projects included meet all applicable transportation planning requirements per Title 23 Code of Federal Regulation Part 450 and satisfy the applicable air quality conformity requirements.

Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of project for federal funding.
