The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) has reviewed your correspondence dated May 2, 2018 and supporting information regarding Amendment 11 to SANDAG 2016/17 – 2020/21 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The amendment adds FTA program funds for various projects in San Diego County. FTA approves this revision for inclusion into the SANDAG 2016/17 – 2020/21 STIP.

We find this amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and to be based on a continuing, comprehensive, and coordinated transportation planning process in accordance with the provisions of 23 USC 134 and 49 USC 5303. In addition, the funds programmed are consistent with anticipated revenues and the amendment does not conflict with current financial planning expectations.
