Subject: Administrative Modification No. 12 to the 2018 Regional

Transportation Improvement Program for the San Diego Association

of Governments

The San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG), using the authority delegated to it by Caltrans, approves Administrative Modification No. 12 to the SANDAG 2018 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP). This constitutes an administrative modification to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). The changes are consistent with the Federal Transportation Improvement Program/FSTIP amendment and administrative modification procedures.

Administrative Modification No. 12 makes a change to one project within San Diego County. It adds a project to the grouped project listing for the Highway Maintenance program (CAL194) and is being processed out of order so that Caltrans can advertise and award these projects before the end of the fiscal year.

The project contained within Administrative Modification No. 12 relies on the state's financial capacity. This administrative modification adds \$3.23 million in additional programming of Highway Maintenance funds.

The project change in Administrative Modification No. 12 does not affect air quality conformity and continues to conform to the applicable State Implementation Plan. The proposed amendment does not reflect any changes in the design, concept, or scope of the project or the conformity analysis years as modeled for the regional emissions analysis of the 2018 RTIP and San Diego Forward: The 2019 Federal Regional Transportation Plan. The investments described in the 2018 RTIP, as revised with Administrative Modification No. 12, make progress toward achieving the performance targets set by the region in accordance with the applicable provisions and requirements of 23 Code of Federal Regulations part 450.
